APPRENTICE GRANTS FOR EMPLOYERS

From December 1st 2010, the National Apprenticeship Service (NAS) are making grants available to provide valuable financial support to employers wishing to take on an unemployed Apprentice aged 16, 17 and 18 years. There are a total of 450 grants of £2000 available to small employers (50 employees), who wish to take on an **Apprentice FOR THE FIRST TIME.** Either the employer or the apprentice must be based in the East Midlands to be eligible.
